What is AI and Why Use It?

Artificial Intelligence (AI) tools like ChatGPT can help you brainstorm ideas, draft communications, and streamline repetitive tasks. They're not a replacement for your expertise but a way to enhance your work.

Ethical Considerations

When using AI, always keep these principles in mind:

1. **Protect Privacy:** Never input sensitive or personal information about participants.
 2. **Review and Verify:** Always double-check AI outputs for accuracy and relevance.
 3. **Be Transparent:** Let others know when AI has assisted in creating content.
 4. **Adapt for Use:** AI suggestions are a starting point—refine them to fit your needs.
 5. **Avoid Over-Reliance:** AI should complement, not replace, your professional judgment.
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Tips for Using AI Effectively

1. **Be Specific:**
 - Include details like your audience, goals, and context.
 - Example: "Draft an email inviting out-of-school youth to a career fair."
 2. **Iterate and Refine:**
 - Adjust your prompt if the output is too vague or unrelated.
 - Add more details: "Focus on incentives like free food or prizes."
 3. **Start Small:**
 - Use AI for quick tasks, like brainstorming or drafting ideas, before tackling larger projects.
 4. **Experiment:**
 - Explore AI for various tasks—brainstorming, scheduling, or generating creative ideas.
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Sample Prompts to Try

Recruitment Strategies:

- "What are creative ways to recruit youth aged 16-24 for a workforce program?"
- "How can we use local events to attract disengaged youth?"

Retention Strategies:

- "What follow-up activities keep participants engaged over time?"
- "How can mentorship programs improve retention rates for out-of-school youth?"



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Sample Prompts to Try, *continued*

Career Planning:

- "What activities can help youth explore career pathways using tools like NCCareers.org?"
- "Suggest ways to combine career exploration with hands-on skills training."

- "What are interactive ways to teach financial literacy to young participants?"
 - "How can entrepreneurial training engage youth in workforce programs?"
