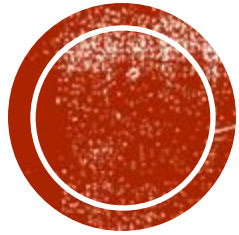

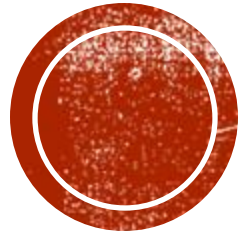
# **The guide provides comprehensive resources for students transitioning from high school to:**

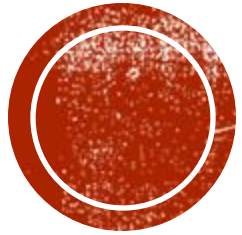
